I would like to introduce myself as one of the Advisors on board United Way of India (Bangalore), to align with universities to join with us for **India Plog Run**, an effort to make the country single use plastic free and to sensitize people on effective management of plastic disposal. I am also the co-founder of Nature Diaries, a decade old, successful nature & wildlife conservation education organization, that works with school and college students to sensitize them to our natural environment and it's related issues.

The event is being organised on 2nd October 2019. It is an initiative by United Way of India and Go Native to commemorate the 150th birth anniversary of Mahatma Gandhi on Plastic Awareness campaign. I am very happy to announce that Swacch Bharat Mission (SBM - U) is supporting our initiative. I would like to invite Basaveshwara Arts College and associates to join this activity and help detox your neighborhood.

Plogging is a combination of jogging with picking up litter. Started as a group activity in Sweden in 2016, it has now spread to several countries in the West increasing awareness about plastic pollution. With India Plog Run, we aim to create awareness and right disposal of plastic waste. This is also in alignment with our Prime Minister's message to free our nation from single use plastic. India Plog Run is envisioned as the largest and first of its kind community driven awareness activity on plastic pollution in the country. It will mobilize over 2 lakh citizens, in 50 cities, covering 500 locations and cleaning 7.5 lakh kilometres, all on a single day. Post the event, United Way India has ambitious plans to engage and spread awareness on plastic pollution in 1 lakh schools and 100 important historical tourist destinations. We will activate local communities across the country to undertake this activity on a regular basis.
