THE INSTITUTIONAL STRATEGIC/PERSPECTIVE PLAN IS EFFECTIVELY DEPLOYED

The major recommendations during the third cycle of accreditation by NAAC in the year 2020 are related to the launching of more and more Vocational/Certificate and Add on Courses. As part of academic quality improvement, they recommended to start job-oriented courses for skill enrichment. The IQAC in consultation with the Staff Council put forward the recommendations before the Management and the Management designed a strategic plan with far sighted vision, consequently the college introduced number of jobs oriented Add on courses on different subjects in the courses during the year.

Continuing with the tradition of striving for excellence, the Academic Calendar would be prepared, as per the Academic Calendar of the Affiliating University (RCUB) with additional activity. This year, we plan to make the Academic Calendar more 'action-oriented', especially as per the needs of various Departments. So, we plan to do the following additional activities in the next academic session.
